



**Tulloch Private Bin Pokolbin
Dry Red Shiraz 2005 \$35**

There'll be a stampede at Tulloch when word gets out. This is history in a bottle: made from the 100-plus-year-old vines of the Tal lawanta vineyard under a label that left the Tulloch family in 1969 and came back to it in 2001, with the help of Inglewood and Angoves. Hunter veteran Jay Tulloch surely sees in this wine a resemblance to the distinctive reds made, under the same label, by his father Hector until Hector's death in 1965. This is pure, beautifully made Hunter shiraz - intensely flavoured, finely structured, silk smooth and elegant. There's not a rough edge to it - tribute to superb fruit, captured by winemaker Jim Chatto's mastery of the regional style.

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
