Tulloch 2008 Verdelho

THIS admirable Hunter Valley white won a rare trophy and the only gold medal in the current vintage Verdelho class in the 2008 Hunter Valley Wine Show at Singleton. It is green tinged light gold in the glass and has orange peel and musk scents. Lively citrus flavour shows on the front of the palate and passionfruit and lime zest characters chime in on the middle palate. Refreshingly crisp slatey acid comes through at the finish. It would be good with Vietnamese spring rolls, country-style chicken terrine with pickled vegetables or chicken schnitzel and tabouli salad. It can be found in some wine stores and at the Tulloch cellar door on the corner of McDonalds and DeBeyers roads, Pokolbin.
