Tulloch Verdelho 2008, \$16

A trophy-winner at the recent Hunter Valley show, the Tulloch version of verdelho demonstrates the potential of the variety to produce refreshingly simple, fruit-driven dry whites of a cheery nature. Various tropical fruits show out in the bouquet and palate; lively acidity adds zest and the overall balance is near-perfect. Considering the many enjoyable verdelhos made across the country, one has to wonder at the surging interest in far less consistent white varieties such as pinot gris/grigio.
